### Where can it lead to?

## What are the entry requirements for this course?

You must be over the age of 19 to apply for this course.

GCSE grade 4/5 or C in English & Maths or a Level 1 in a trade related subject.

Alternatively, we may be able to consider your application on the basis of previous experience.

You will be contacted after applying for clarification of entry requirements, you will need to evidence achievement of a GCSE grade 4/5 or C, if you are unable to evidence your grades you may be asked to complete an initial assessment.
