This course will support students who wish to progress on to a Level 2 mainstream course. It is particularly useful for learners transitioning from Foundation Learning and for those learners who are joining Moulton College who may experience anxiety, school refusers or certain health issues.

Students will be expected to study Maths and English with mainstream students to help support the transition.

What will I learn on the course?

You will study a range of units including:

- Being organised
- Developing a personal progression plan
- Running an event
- Preparing and cooking food
- Caring for and feeding animals

Where can it lead to?

You will be able to progress onto a Level 2 course in a mainstream environment in your chosen vocation. We can also provide advice about alternative external provisions if progression at Moulton is not an option.

What are the entry requirements for this course?

No formal qualifications are required, but you will need to attend an interview to identify your interests and support needs.

Good to know

If you complete all course work you will achieve a level 1 BTEC Introductory Certificate in Vocational Studies.

How will this course help me to understand environmental and sustainability issues?

During your course you will study environmental issues such as air pollution, global warming, litter and biodiversity. You will complete a practical study which may include ways to reduce electrical output and water in the home. You will also learn about recycling and the benefits of promoting biodiversity for bees, butterflies and birds.
